Participants will meet at the Quemahoning Family Recreation Area off of Quemahoning Dam Road, Hollsopple PA for registration and instructions, then shuttle to put on the river by 11:00am. **Wilderness Voyageurs** will provide rafts or individual, inflatable “duckies,” depending on the water level. The trip is run as “guide assisted” – you captain your own craft but guides are close by for assistance. Must be at least 12 years of age, with signed parent/guardian consent.
